The Purpose of Pathwork

This quote from Pathwork Lecture 141 *Return To the Original Level of Perfection* gives a clear picture of the **purpose of Pathwork**. The lecture states that Pathwork is **very important** and provides a **basic set of tools** to aid the Pathworker in attaining the **fulfillment of his or her life**. Pathwork is to be *applied*, <u>not</u> **merely explored intellectually** as just another metaphysical way of making sense of life. As it states, this lecture is not only for beginning students but for mature and advanced student as well.

The rest of this lecture (not included here) provides a beautiful outline of the Pathwork process and describes how this process intends to help the Pathworker identify and dissolve obstacles, pseudo-solutions to the problems of life that he or she has created and which in the end stand in the way of accessing the power and wisdom of his or her inner Source, that core within wherein all the resources needed for fulfilling one's destiny reside.

Every once in a while it is important to restate

what the pathwork is and

what it is supposed to accomplish.

It is **important** to **always** see this in a **new light**, from **different angles**.

This path

is **not** supposed to be taken as a **cure**, **nor** is it to be taken as a **luxury** –

- indulged in merely because it is "interesting,"
- because it certainly cannot do any "harm" and
- one's life leaves room for such a pursuit.

In reality, it is

much more important, much more basic.

And if it be

a cure, or a healing,

it is that only secondarily.

The <u>true meaning</u> of such a path is
finding <u>within</u> the self
everything necessary
for the fulfillment of
one's personal destiny.

If this path is seen from this point of view, much misunderstanding will be eliminated.
